Leading EDGE requires all employers to pay interns, which is critical to creating equitable opportunities for college students who rely on summer employment income. However, nonprofits and small businesses do not always have the budget for additional staff, preventing them from offering meaningful experiences – and benefiting from an intern's time and talent.
